

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE
OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, OF 1950

WHEREAS, the City Plan Commission of the City of Urbana, Illinois, which is the City Zone Commission, did on Monday, the 13th day of August, 1962, at the hour of 4 o'clock p.m. conduct a public hearing pursuant to the required public notice in the Community Building at the address of 120 West Elm Street, Urbana, Illinois, to consider the hereinafter described proposed amendment to the Zoning Ordinance, and,

WHEREAS, said Plan Commission at said hearing heard all persons desiring to be heard either for or against said amendment, and found that such proposed amendment is desirable for the public welfare of the City of Urbana, Illinois, and that the same is not detrimental to the property owners in the vicinity, and,

WHEREAS, the City Plan Commission recommended the amendment as hereinafter described for adoption of the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

Reclassification and rezoning of the following described real estate from the classification of R-1, One and Two Family Residential Area, to R-3, Multiple Family Residential Only Area; the description of said real estate is, to-wit:

Lots Seven (7) through Eighteen (18) both inclusive and Lots Twenty-five (25) through Thirty (30) both inclusive of James S. Busey's Addition to the City of Urbana, Illinois, which includes the square block bounded by Illinois, California, Race and Cedar Streets, and the north one-half of the block bounded by Illinois, California, Cedar and Birch Streets, in the City of Urbana, Illinois.
