

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE  
OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, OF 1950

WHEREAS, the City Plan Commission of the City of Urbana, which is the City Zone Commission, did on Monday, the 25th day of February, 1963, at the hour of 4:00 o'clock p.m. conduct a public hearing pursuant to the required public notice, in the Community Building at the address of 120 West Elm Street, Urbana, Illinois, to consider the hereinafter described proposed amendment to the Zoning Ordinance, and,

WHEREAS, said Plan Commission at said hearing heard all persons desiring to be heard either for or against said amendment, and found that such proposed amendment is desirable for the public welfare of the City of Urbana, Illinois, and that the same is not detrimental to the property owners in the vicinity, and,

WHEREAS, the City Plan Commission recommended the amendment as herein-after described for adoption of the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

That the Zoning Ordinance of Urbana, Illinois of 1950 is hereby amended by the following:

Article VI - R-2, Multiple Family Residential, Section One. Use Regulations. Subsection 9., to add the provision "Doctor's Office" after Hospitals and Clinics; Nursing Home.
