AMENDED DOGS CONTROL ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that Sections 5.9 and 5.10 of Article II - Dogs, of the Code of the City of Urbana, Illinois, 1954, heretofore adopted are hereby repealed, and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that Sections 5.9 and 5.10 of said Code shall provide as follows:

SECTION 5.9 When any dog:

- (1) Has caused damage to the property of any person, or
- (2) Has bitten a person other than the owner, or
- (3) Has chased or barked at an automobile or other vehicle upon the public streets of the City, or
- (4) Is found without a tag indicating inoculation against rabies within twelve months of the date of finding, or
- (5) Has followed children to school, or
- (6) Seriously or viciously did frighten, annoy, nip, scratch, push, growl at, bark at, jump at or bite any person, or
- (7) Is a public nuisance; and a dog is in one way a prima facie nuisance when it is at large;

then such dog is subject to being impounded by any City of Urbana Dog Control Officer.

The City Council may provide a pound for the impounding of dogs in accordance with the laws of the State, or may direct any City of Urbana Dog Control Officer, appointed by the Mayor, to cause such dogs and stray dogs to be impounded in other facilities for the impounding of dogs within the county.

SECTION 5.10 Any dog impounded as provided in this Article may be redeemed by the owner or keeper of such dog upon payment of One Dollar and Fifty Cents (\$1.50) per day to the Municipal Collector of said City, for the feeding and care of such dog for each day or part of a day that it has been impounded. Any dog so impounded which has not been vaccinated against rabies shall be vaccinated before delivery to the owner or person redeeming such dog, and the person redeeming the dog shall pay the veterinary for vaccination for such dog, before receiving the dog. Any dog impounded as provided in this Article not redeemed within seven (7) days after being impounded shall be disposed of.

Any owner of a dog which is a public nuisance, as such owner is guilty of maintaining a public nuisance; or if any owner of a dog allows such dog to be subject to the foregoing provisions of this ordinance; in either event, the owner of such dog is in violation of these ordinances and shall be fined \$5.00 for the first violation, \$10.00 for the second violation, and between \$20.00 and \$200.00 for each additional violation.

This ordinance becomes effective May 1st, 1963.

AMENDED DOGS CONTROL ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that Sections 5.9 and 5.10 of Article II - Dogs, of the Code of the City of Urbana, Illinois, 1954, heretofore adopted are hereby repealed, and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that Sections 5.9 and 5.10 of said Code shall provide as follows:

SECTION 5.9 When any dog:

- (1) Has caused damage to the property of any person, or
- (2) Has bitten a person other than the owner, or
- (3) Has chased or barked at an automobile or other vehicle upon the public streets of the City, or
- (4) Is found without a tag indicating inoculation against rabies within twelve months of the date of finding, or
- (5) Has followed children to school, or
- (6) Seriously or viciously did frighten, annoy, nip, scratch, push, growl at, bark at, jump at or bite any person, or
- (7) Is a public nuisance; and a dog is in one way a prima facie nuisance when it is at large;

then such dog is subject to being impounded by any City of Urbana Dog Control Officer.

The City Council may provide a pound for the impounding of dogs in accordance with the laws of the State, or may direct any City of Urbana Dog Control Officer, appointed by the Mayor, to cause such dogs and stray dogs to be impounded in other facilities for the impounding of dogs within the county.

SECTION 5.10 Any dog impounded as provided in this Article may be redeemed by the owner or keeper of such dog upon payment of One Dollar and Fifty Cents (\$1.50) per day to the Municipal Collector of said City, for the feeding and care of such dog for each day or part of a day that it has been impounded. Any dog so impounded which has not been vaccinated against rabies shall be vaccinated before delivery to the owner or person redeeming such dog, and the person redeeming the dog shall pay the veterinary for vaccination for such dog, before receiving the dog. Any dog impounded as provided in this Article not redeemed within seven (7) days after being impounded shall be disposed of.

Any owner of a dog which is a public nuisance as such owner is guilty of maintaining a public nuisance; or if any owner of a dog allows such dog to be subject to the foregoing provisions of this ordinance; in either event, the owner of such dog is in violation of these ordinances and shall be fined \$5.00 for the first violation, \$10.00 for the second violation, and between \$20.00 and \$200.00 for each additional violation.

This ordinance becomes effective May 1st, 1963.
