AN ORDINANCE IN REGARD TO RE-CONNECTION OF THREE FIRE HYDRANTS FROM SIX-INCH MAIN TO NEW TEN-INCH MAIN, ON EAST MAIN STREET

WHEREAS, the Chief of the Fire Department of the City of Urbana, Illinois, the Fire Marshall, recommends to the City Council that the fire hydrants located at the following locations be converted from the six-inch main to a new ten-inch main being installed on East Main Street by the Northern Illinois Water Corporation, and,

WHEREAS, it appears to be for the best interests of the people of the City of Urbana, Illinois, for public safety and fire protection to have such fire hydrants converted from the six-inch main and connected to such new ten-inch main so located, and,

WHEREAS, there is a necessity for conversion of such fire hydrants from said six-inch main to the new ten-inch main, at the following specified locations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that the three fire hydrants located in the City of Urbana be converted from the six-inch main and connected to a new ten-inch main being installed, in the following locations:

Hydrants located on East Main Street, in the City of Urbana, Illinois;
Between the addresses of 1904 and 1908 East Main Street;
On the west side of the house at 2012 East Main Street;
And between 2106 and 2110 East Main Street.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS,

That the City Clerk of said City is hereby directed to send a certified copy
of this ordinance to the Northern Illinois Water Corporation.
