AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF AN ALLEY

WHEREAS, three-fourths of all of the aldermen of the City of Urbana,
Illinois authorized by law to be elected have determined that the public interests
will be subserved by vacating a portion of an alley as hereinafter set forth;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

The City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois hereby vacates the following portion of Cherry Alley in the City of Urbana, Illinois, described and bounded as follows:

That part of Cherry Alley situated in the City of Urbana, Illinois and being an east-west alley between Elm and Green Streets and Race and Broadway Streets, described as follows:

Commencing at the southwest corner of Lot 52 of the Original Town of Urbana, thence east forty feet on the south line of said lot, thence south to the north line of Lot 80, thence West forty feet on the north line of Lot 80 to the northwest corner of Lot 80, thence north to the point of beginning, all being situated in the City of Urbana, County of Champaign, State of Illinois.

All of the above described property is situated in the City of Urbana, Illinois and the title to said land included within such description so vacated shall vest in the then owners of the property abutting on the north and south sides of said portion of said alley so vacated.

The City of Urbana, Illinois hereby reserves easements upon and under said portion of said alley for the maintenance and repair of all sewers and drains and all public service facilities which are located on or under the surface of any part of said portion of said alley.

The vesting of title in the portion of said alley shall be subject to any easement or easements for public utilities, their successors and assigns, to operate, maintain, remove and reconstruct their facilities and as are now operated and maintained in, over or under any portion of the said portion of the said alley so vacated, this corporate authority having determined that it is both necessary

and desirable for the public interests that the public services of all of said public utilities be continued by the means of said facilities.

Adopted by the affirmative vote of at least three-fourths of all aldermen authorized by law to be elected this day of September, 1963.
