

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE  
OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, OF 1950

WHEREAS, the City Plan Commission of the City of Urbana, Illinois, did on Monday, October 12, 1964, at the hour of 4 o'clock p.m. conduct a public hearing pursuant to the required public notice, in the Community Building at the address of 120 West Elm Street, Urbana, Illinois, to consider the hereinafter described proposed amendment to the Zoning Ordinance, and,

WHEREAS, said Plan Commission at said hearing heard all persons desiring to be heard either for or against said amendment, and found that such proposed amendment is desirable for the public welfare of the City of Urbana, Illinois, and that the same is not detrimental to the property owners in the vicinity, and,


WHEREAS, the City Plan Commission recommended the amendment as hereinafter described for adoption of the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:


Recalssification and rezoning of the following described real estate to R-3 District, Multiple Family Residential Only; the description of said real estate is, to-wit:

Lot Six (6) and all of Lot Seven (7), except the South twenty-four (24) feet thereof, of Archie J. Hartle's Second (2nd) Subdivision of a part of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Sixteen (16), Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Nine (9) East of the Third Principal Meridian, situated in the County of Champaign, in the State of Illinois.
