

ORDINANCE OF REPEAL AND AMENDMENT TO
CHAPTER 14, ARTICLE I, AND CHAPTER 18, SECTION 18.6 OF
THE CODE OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, 1954,
IN REGARD TO LICENSES AND HAULING GARBAGE AND
TRASH FROM OUTSIDE THE CITY TO THE CITY DUMP.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

That the ordinances which provide tags for garbage cans for which garbage is hauled from outside the City to the City Dump are hereby repealed.

Haulers of garbage and trash from outside the City to the City Dump shall obtain a license from this date to haul garbage and trash from residential places within one and one-half miles outside the City Limits of Urbana, and east of Wright Street and Wright Street extended. Licenses are obtainable only by commercial haulers with a license for hauling from inside the City which already pay an annual license fee of \$100; in addition, the annual license for hauling from outside the City in such manner is \$40. These licenses to the haulers and fees from them are in lieu of taxes and in lieu of garbage can tag fees. Such licenses and permits for hauling garbage and trash from outside the City to the City Dump shall be paid quarterly in advance in accordance with proper schedule available at the Office of the Municipal Collector. Violations are subject to penalty and revocation or suspension of such licenses or permits and subject to a fine of not to exceed \$200 for each violation.
