

AN ORDINANCE WHICH PROVIDES FOR THE PERMANENT  
REGISTRATION OF VOTERS IN THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

That pursuant to Article IV of the Election Code of the State of Illinois, said City adopts said Article IV and the provisions of said IV, and the system of registration of voters maintained by Champaign County, Illinois, in reference to the area of said City, and makes the same applicable to all municipal elections, and primary nomination elections of said City for City elective officers, and said registration shall have application to all City of Urbana elections from this date.
