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AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE  
OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, OF 1950

WHEREAS, the City Plan Commission of the City of Urbana, Illinois, did on Monday, November 9, 1964, at the hour of 4 o'clock p.m. conduct a public hearing pursuant to the required public notice, in the Community Building at the address of 120 West Elm Street, Urbana, Illinois, to consider the hereinafter described proposed amendment to the Zoning Ordinance, and,

WHEREAS, said Plan Commission at said hearing heard all persons desiring to be heard either for or against said amendment, and found that such proposed amendment is desirable for the public welfare of the City of Urbana, Illinois, and that the same is not detrimental to the property owners in the vicinity, and,

WHEREAS, the City Plan Commission recommended the amendment as hereinafter described for adoption of the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

Reclassification and rezoning of the following described real estate from the classification of R-2 District, Multiple Family Residential Area, to R-5 District, Fraternities, Sororities, and Dormitories; the description of said real estate is, to-wit:

Beginning at a point 66 feet West of the Southeast corner of Lot Four (4) in Block 1 of Burpee, Curtiss and Somers Addition of Out Lots to the City of Urbana, thence North parallel to the center line of Lincoln Avenue 120 feet, thence West 66 feet, thence South 120 feet to the North line of Green Street, thence East 66 feet to the place of beginning, situated in the City of Urbana, County of Champaign, and the State of Illinois.
