AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY  
TO THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the following described area is contiguous with the City of Urbana, Illinois, and is dedicated to the public for street and sidewalk purposes, and no owners or electors reside thereon; and,

WHEREAS, at least two-thirds of the Aldermen of the City Council are of the opinion that it would be for the best interests of the City of Urbana, Illinois, and in compliance with the statutes of the State of Illinois in regard to annexations of territories to municipalities, that the following described territory be annexed to the City of Urbana, Illinois, as a part of said City and made within the City Limits of said City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS.


SECTION I. That the territory described as follows to-wit:

A segment of Country Squire Drive which extends southeasterly and easterly from Country Squire Drive and Squire Court, already within the limits of said City, southeasterly and easterly to the east boundary of Country Squire Estates I, which boundary line extends from the northeast corner of Lot No. 1035 to the southeast corner of Lot No. 1034 of said Country Squire Estates I Subdivision, situated in the County of Champaign and State of Illinois,


be, and the same is hereby annexed to and shall hereafter be a part of the City of Urbana, Illinois, and the corporate limits of the City of Urbana be, and the same shall be changed so as to include said territory within the corporate limits of said City.

SECTION II. The Clerk of the City of Urbana, Illinois, shall record with the Recorder of Deeds of Champaign County, Illinois, a copy of this ordinance, together with an accurate map of the annexed territory.
