

ORDINANCE IN REGARD TO  
MOVING OF BUILDINGS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA,  
ILLINOIS:

That Article V, Section 30.57, of the Code of the City of  
Urbana, Illinois, shall provide as follows:

No. 1. No building shall be moved through or over  
any street in the City to any other lot in the City  
before such buildings have been inspected by the  
Commissioner of Public Works for fire hazards, health  
conditions, plumbing, electrical installations and  
general building structure. Nor shall any such  
building be inhabited for rental purposes until it  
has been determined by the Commissioner of Public  
Works and approved by the City Council that such  
building meets the minimum housing standards for  
rental premises of the City of Urbana.

No. 2. No moving permit shall be issued for any  
building unless it has been found by the Commissioner  
of Public Works, upon the consultation with a  
professional, registered architect, and the approval  
of the City Council, that the exterior architectural  
and functional plan of the said building will, when  
placed upon the new site, not be so at variance with  
either the architectural appeal and functional plan  
of the structures already constructed or in the course  
of construction in the immediate neighborhood or the  
character of the applicable district so as to cause  
a potential depreciation in property values of said  
neighborhood within said applicable district.

Further the seeker of the permit will supply the  
Commission of Public Works and the City Council with  
the following:

1. A photograph of the house to be moved
2. A photograph of the plot area
3. A diagram of the plot plan
