

AN ORDINANCE OF AMENDMENT TO "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING REGULATIONS FOR THE SUBDIVISION OF LAND".

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA,
ILLINOIS:

That "An Ordinance Providing Regulations for the Subdivision of Land", adopted by the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, on July 1, 1957, be amended as follows:

In Section 3, Paragraph D.5. in regard to pavements for major streets, instead of the provision, "If constructed with bituminous concrete, the pavement shall be not less than 2½ inches thick laid over a base of crushed stone or gravel, installed in two courses, not less than 8 inches thick after compaction", these provisions shall read, "If constructed with bituminous concrete, the pavement shall be not less than 8 inches thick including 6 inches of base course and 2 inches of surface course, and should subgrade conditions warrant additional treatment as determined by the City Engineer, additional subbase material shall be required."

In Section 3. D. 6, in regard to pavements for all other streets or alleys, instead of the provision, "bituminous concrete not less than 2½ inches over a base of crushed stone or gravel not less than 7 inches thick after compaction"; or pavement described as Class A-3 in the current specifications of the Division of Highways of the State of Illinois constructed on a gravel or crushed stone base having a compacted thickness of not less than 7 inches shall provide, "for bituminous concrete not less than 7 inches thick including 5½ inches of base course and 1½ inches of surface course, and should subgrade conditions warrant additional treatment as determined by the City Engineer, additional sub-base material shall be required."
