ORDINANCE IN REGARD TO STANDING COMMITTEES OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

That the standing committee of the City of Urbana, Illinois, entitled Public Safety Committee (Fire and Police) replaces and includes the functions of the standing committees of said Council which heretofore existed, which were entitled Committee on Fire and Water and Committee on Police and Traffic, and which existed from the year 1954 to this May 1st, 1965.

The Public Safety Committee shall have jurisdiction and authority over all matters pertaining to the Fire Department and the water supply and distribution system of the City; and authority over all matters pertaining to the Police Department, the exercise of police powers of the City, traffic regulations, parking facilities and regulations, traffic control devices; and the Public Safety Committee shall have jurisdiction of related matters in regard to the aforesaid functions.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

That the standing committee of the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, entitled Public Works Committee (Streets and Alleys and Engineering) replaces and includes the functions of the standing committee of said Council which heretofore existed, which was entitled Committee on Streets, Alleys, Sewerage and Drainage, and which existed from the year 1954 to this May 1st, 1965.

The Public Works Committee shall have jurisdiction and authority over all matters pertaining to streets, alleys, sewers and drains in the City, including the supervision of the Street Department, Sewerage and Drainage Departments and Engineering Department.
