

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SALE AT RETAIL OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS WITHIN THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS", AS AMENDED

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

That "An Ordinance Regulating the Sale at Retail of Alcoholic Liquors Within the City of Urbana, Illinois" adopted May 17, 1954, and as amended, shall be amended in reference to Section 7 and Section 11 to provide in lieu of the provisions of Section 7 and Section 11 as follows:

Sec. 7. (Restriction on licenses.) No license of any kind shall be issued to such persons as are prohibited to receive a Retail Liquor Dealer's License by said Illinois Liquor Law.

Not more than One (1) Class (A) License shall be issued in any one year for each 2,500 residents of the City of Urbana; not more than One (1) Class "B" License shall be issued in any one year for each 5,000 residents of the City of Urbana; and not more than One (1) Class "C" License shall be issued in any one year for each 10,000 residents in the City of Urbana. The number of residents to be determined by the last official census of the City of Urbana as made for the purpose of determining the population in connection with the receipt of Motor Fuel Taxes from the State of Illinois.

In case of a surrender or cancellation of any licenses, another license of the same class may be issued to replace the one so surrendered or cancelled.

Sec. 11. (Restricted areas.) Within the City alcoholic liquor or beer shall be sold at retail only within the area zoned as B-1 District, Neighborhood Business or any less restricted area.
