

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN
TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, it appears to the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, that the territory hereinafter described is not within the limits of said City, but is contiguous to said City of Urbana, Illinois, and is dedicated or used for street or highway purposes, within the purview of the laws and statutes made and provided, and no part of the annexed territory is within any other municipality, and,

WHEREAS, it is for the best interests of the people of the City of Urbana, Illinois, that the territory be annexed to the City of Urbana, Illinois, and made a part of said City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That the territory described as follows, to-wit:

The portion of the public street or highway known as West Florida Avenue between the south line of Section 18, in Township 19 North, Range 9 East of the Third Principal Meridian, and the south line of Mt. Hope Cemetery, and which extends between the west line of the southeast quarter of the said Section 18, and the west line and west line extended southward to the south line of said Section 18, of Gallivans Addition to the City of Urbana; situated in the County of Champaign and State of Illinois;

be and the same is hereby annexed to, and shall hereafter be a part of the City of Urbana, Illinois, and that the corporate limits of said City be, and the same shall be changed so as to include said territory within the corporate limits of said City, all in accordance with the laws and statutes made and provided;

SECTION 2. The City Clerk of the City of Urbana, Illinois, shall cause to be recorded with the Recorder of Deeds of the County of Champaign, Illinois, a copy of this ordinance together with an accurate map of the annexed territory, certified as correct by said Clerk of the municipality.

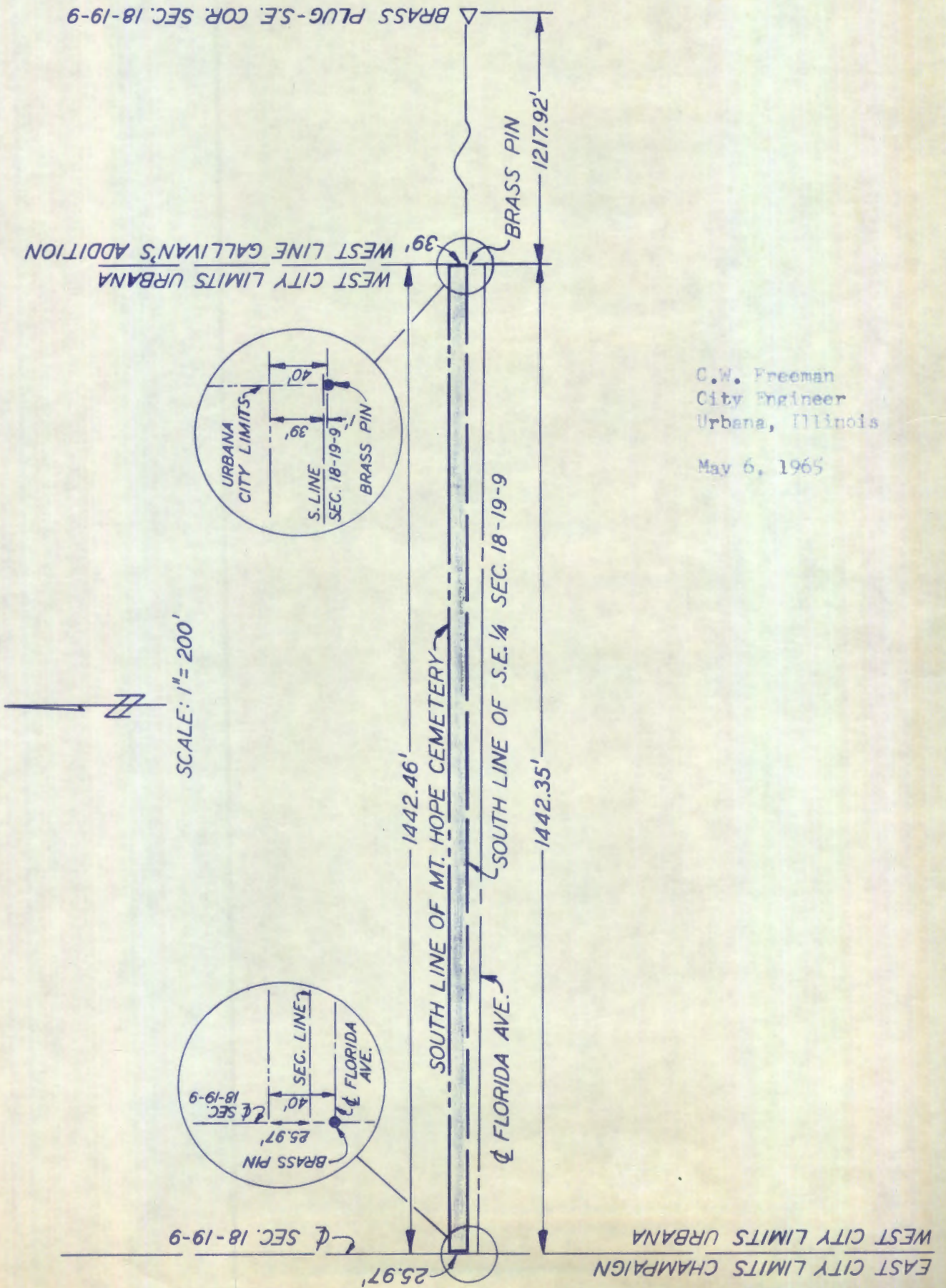

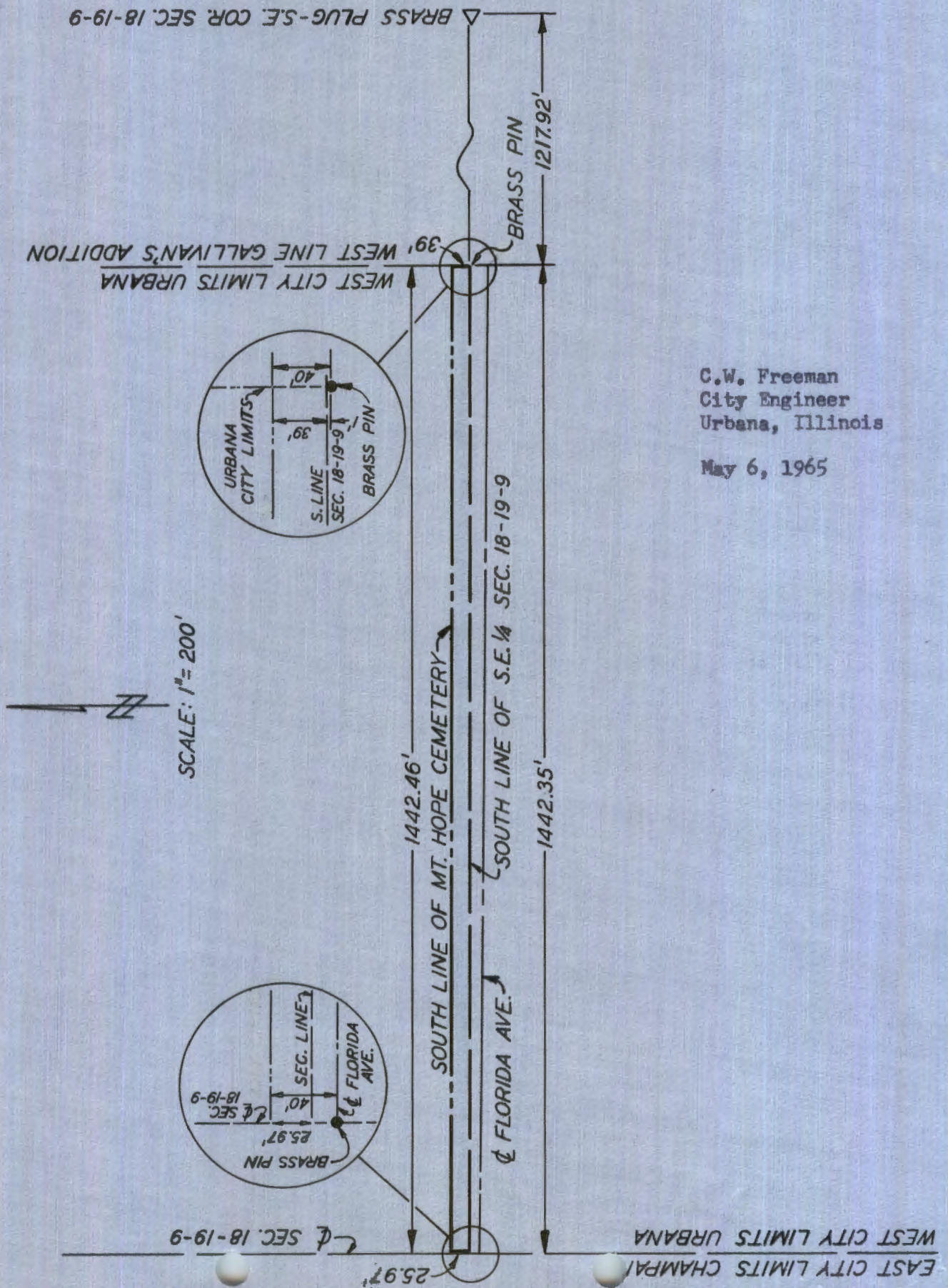
