

AN ORDINANCE FOR LOCATION OF
A FIRE HYDRANT

WHEREAS, the Chief of the Fire Department of the City of Urbana, Illinois, the Fire Marshall, recommends to the City Council that a fire hydrant be located at the following location, and,

WHEREAS, it appears to be for the best interests of the people of the City of Urbana, Illinois, for public safety and fire protection to have such fire hydrant so located, and,

WHEREAS, there is a necessity for the location of a fire hydrant at the following specified locations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that a fire hydrant be located in the City of Urbana, Illinois, at the following location:

On East Washington Street at the Prairie School driveway, between Kinch Street and the East City Limits.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that the City Clerk of said City is hereby directed to send a certified copy of this ordinance to the Northern Illinois Water Corporation.
