

AN ORDINANCE OF AMENDMENT TO
"AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING REGULATIONS
FOR THE SUBDIVISION OF LAND"
ADOPTED JULY 1, 1957,
TO PROVIDE MINIMUM RIGHTS-OF-WAYS
WIDTHS FOR MAJOR LIMITED ACCESS STREETS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
URBANA, ILLINOIS, that "An Ordinance Providing Regulations for
the Subdivision of Land" be amended,


Following Section 3, Paragraph B. 1. (a), by the
addition of Section 3, Paragraph B. 1. (aa) to
provide as follows:

Major streets of limited access classification,
used primarily for through traffic or belt line
traffic, to include streets shown on the official
plan map of the city of Urbana, Illinois, as
major limited access streets, shall have minimum
rights-of-ways of at least One Hundred (100) feet
widths.
