

AN ORDINANCE IN REGARD TO LENGTH OF SERVICE AND REGULATIONS AND COMPENSATION OF MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

As provided in a current ordinance entitled, An Ordinance Fixing Compensation of Officers and Employees, of the City of Urbana, Illinois, adopted April 17th, 1967, for the fiscal year commencing May 1st, 1967; that beginning May 1st, 1967, the monthly salaries of those designated employees of the City of Urbana shall be the base salary listed in said ordinance, and such ordinance for each fiscal year in the future, plus 2% of such base salary for each two years of continuous city employment.

Service of such employees shall be measured as of May 1st of each year.

Continuous service is deemed to mean continuous, full-time service in any City of Urbana employment.

Maximum service for longevity provisions shall be a term of thirty years.

If an employee is drawing retirement or disability benefits based upon employment with the City, and accepts further employment with the City, he is deemed to have severed his continuous employment, and his service accumulation for the longevity purposes will include only his further employment.

This ordinance shall be effective as of and from this date.
