ORDINANCE OF AMENDMENT TO AMENDED ORDINANCES IN REGARD TO FENCES, AS APPEARS IN SECTION 21.17 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, 1954

whereas, the safety of persons and traffic on the streets and at the intersections in the city of Urbana, Illinois, a municipal corporation, involves the heights and maintenance of fences and visibility along said streets and at such intersections;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

That henceforth or until further amended Section 21.17 of the Code of the City of Urbana, Illinois, 1954, and the ordinances of the City of Urbana, Illinois, are hereby amended to provide that:

No personshall within the city, erect, construct or maintain any fence or any section or portion thereof unless the same shall conform to the following requirements and specifications:

(a) On that portion of the premises within thirty-five feet of the property line fronting on a public street, all fences therein shall be at least fifty per cent open and no fence therein shall exceed four feet in height above the surface of the ground; and that fences, bushes, shrubs and other dividers along public and private property lines that extend from one intersection to another intersection in said City shall not exceed four feet in height above street pavement level and shall be at least fifty per cent open, in nature or construction, and to include material fences and bushes, hedges and shrubs, natural growth and constructed dividers and fences.
