ORDINANCE PROHIBITING DISCHARGE OF SANITARY SEWAGE AND INDUSTRIAL WASTE WATER INTO ANY STORM SEWER CONSTRUCTED AS A PART OF THE AMVETS ADDITION PAVEMENT IMPROVEMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana, County of Champaign, State of Illinois, proposes to construct pavements on Fairlawn Drive, Kingston Drive, Briarcliff Drive, Michigan Avenue, Jackson Road and Adams Street, said improvement being designated as Amvets Addition Pavement Improvement No. 137-CS, which said improvement will include a storm sewer system to be constructed as a part thereof,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

1. It shall be unlawful to discharge any sanitary sewage or industrial waste water into any storm sewer constructed and used as part of the Amvets Addition pavement improvement to be constructed in accordance with the plans and specifications.

2. Any person, firm, or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance shall be fined not less than Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense; and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

That the City Clerk of said City transmit two certified copies of this resolution to the Department of Public Works and Buildings, Division of Highways, through its District Engineer, State Highway Building, Paris, Illinois.
