

AN ORDINANCE OF AMENDMENT TO AN ORDINANCE
ENTITLED "A TEMPORARY ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER
3 OF THE CITY CODE OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, 1954"
ADOPTED JULY 3, 1967


BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois that Section 3.11, of Chapter 3, of the Urbana City Code, 1954, be further amended in regard to free-standing signs to provide that no free-standing signs shall be erected larger in area than 100 square feet, rather than 56 square feet; and,

That a sign with two (2) parallel faces, back-to-back, can have an area on each of such faces a maximum of 100 square feet, in place of 56 square feet; and,


For signs constructed with more faces or with a cylindrical or other shapes, the total sign area shall not exceed 100 square feet instead of 56 square feet.

This ordinance amends the ordinance entitled "A Temporary Ordinance Amending Chapter 3 of the City Code of Urbana, Illinois, 1954", adopted July 3rd, 1967.
