

AN ORDINANCE FOR LOCATION OF FIRE HYDRANTS

WHEREAS, the Chief of the Fire Department of the City of Urbana, Illinois, recommends to the City Council that fire hydrants be located at the following locations, and

WHEREAS, it appears to be for the best interests of the people of the City of Urbana, Illinois, for public safety and fire protection to have such fire hydrants so located, and


WHEREAS, there is a necessity for the location of fire hydrants at the following specified locations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that fire hydrants be located in the City of Urbana, Illinois, at the following locations:


1. Northwest corner of Eliot and Anderson Streets.
2. Lynn Street between Main and Green Streets.
3. Stoughton Street between Coler and McCollough Streets.
4. On the South side of Fairview Avenue between the addresses of 1107 and 1109.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that the City Clerk of said City is hereby directed to send a certified copy of this ordinance to the Northern Illinois Water Corporation.


