## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS OF 1950

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that; the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Urbana, Illinois, of 1950 be amended as follows:

1. The Title of Article XIII be rephrased to read, Non-Conforming Uses and Lots of Record; and,

## 2. Add to Article XIII;

Section 8. In all zoning districts, a building or structure for any of the uses permitted in the respective districts may be erected on a lot recorded before the adoption of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Urbana, Illinois of 1950, November 6, 1950, which has less than the minimum lot area or width specified for the respective districts, provided that all other requirements of this Ordinance including yard, height and off street parking for the respective districts are complied with; provided further that such lot must be in separate ownership and not of continuous frontage with other lots in the same ownership. If two or more lots or combinations of lots and portions of lots with continuous frontage in single ownership are of record at the time of passage of this amendment to the Ordinance of 1950, or thereafter, and if all or part of the lots do not meet the requirements for lot area or width as established by this Ordinance, the lands involved shall be considered to be an undivided parcel for the purposes of this Ordinance, and no portion of said parcel shall be used which does not meet the lot area or width requirements established by this Ordinance.
