AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, OF 1950

WHEREAS, the City Plan Commission of the City of Urbana, Illinois, did on Monday, June 3rd, 1968, at the hour of 4 o'clock p.m. conduct a public hearing pursuant to the required public notice, in the City Building at the address of 400 South Vine Street, Urbana, Illinois, to consider the hereinafter described proposed amendment to the Zoning Ordinance, and,

WHEREAS, said Plan Commission at said hearing heard all persons desiring to be heard either for or against said amendment, and found that such proposed amendment is desirable for the public welfare of the City of Urbana, Illinois, and that the same is not detrimental to the property owners in the vicinity, and,

WHEREAS, the City Plan Commission recommended the amendment as hereinafter described for adoption of the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

Reclassification and rezoning of the following described real estate from the classification of R-l District, Single and Two-Family Residential, to R-3 District, Multiple Family Residential Only; the description of said real estate is, to-wit:

East Half $(\frac{1}{2})$ of Lots 13 and 18, of Laben Littler's Addition, in the Southwest Quarter $(SW^{1}_{\frac{1}{4}})$ of the Northeast Quarter $(NE^{1}_{\frac{1}{4}})$ in Section 17, Township 19N, Range 9E of the 3rd Principal Meridian, situated in the City of Urbana, Champaign County and State of Illinois.
