

AN ORDINANCE FOR REMOVAL OF FIRE HYDRANTS

WHEREAS, the Chief of the Fire Department of the City of Urbana, Illinois, the Fire Marshall, recommends to the City Council that fire hydrants be removed from the following locations, and,

WHEREAS, it appears to be for the best interest of the people of the City of Urbana, Illinois, for public safety and fire protection to have such fire hydrants so removed, and,

WHEREAS, there is a necessity for the removal of fire hydrants at the following specified locations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that removal of fire hydrants from the City of Urbana, Illinois, in the following locations:


The intersection of California Street and Goodwin Avenue.  
The intersection of Illinois Street and Goodwin Avenue.  
The South side of Illinois Street between Goodwin Avenue ~~and~~ and Gregory Place Street.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that the City Clerk of said City is hereby directed to send a certified copy of this ordinance to the Northern Illinois Water Corporation.
