

ORDINANCE IN REGARD TO SICK LEAVE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA,
ILLINOIS:

All salaried employees of the City of Urbana will be under a
new sick leave program outlined below:

Starting May 1st, 1968, all salaried employees will be credited
with 12 days sick leave.

Starting May 1st, 1968, all salaried employees will be credited
with 1 day sick leave per month until the employee has accumulated a
total of 36 days.


A Doctor's certificate will be required of all salaried employ-
ees if sick or injured more than two days.

All employees will be required to be confined to their home or
be in a hospital during any sickness or accident except they will be
allowed to go to a hospital or doctor's office for treatment.

All salaried employees will be required to furnish the head of
the department involved, a Doctor's certificate every seven days of
sickness or accident showing cause for the employees absence from
duty.

Sick leave time will not apply in cases of line of duty accid-
ents as workman compensation and pension disability will be in
effect. The requirements of Doctor's certificates and confinement
periods will apply.
