

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE IN REGARD TO TAXICAB RATES
AND FARES

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, that Section 31.46, Chapter 31, Taxicabs, Article IV. Meters and Fares, be amended to provide as follows:

The fares and charges for taxicab service for one passenger shall be forty-five cents (\$.45) for the first one-fourth mile or fraction thereof, and ten cents (\$.10) for each additional one-fourth mile or fraction thereof; and if more than one passenger is carried on the same trip, there shall be an additional charge of ten cents (\$.10) for each such additional passenger who leaves the taxicab prior to or at the time the meter is cleared. On days of University of Illinois home football games, between the hours of 11:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., the fare per person, to or from the business districts of the city and the University of Illinois Memorial Stadium shall be fifty cents (\$.50). The business districts referred to are those classified as B-2 Central Commercial Districts as defined in the Zoning Ordinance of the city. All trips from residential areas during the hours on the days above specified shall be made at meter rates.
