

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE  
OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, OF 1950

WHEREAS, the City Plan Commission of the City of Urbana, Illinois, currently did conduct a public hearing pursuant to the required public notice, in the City Building, at the address of 400 South Vine Street, Urbana, Illinois, to consider the hereinafter described proposed amendment to the Zoning Ordinance, and,

WHEREAS, said Plan Commission at said hearing heard all persons desiring to be heard either for or against said amendment, and found that such proposed amendment was desirable for the public welfare of the City of Urbana, Illinois, and that the same is not detrimental to the property owners in the vicinity, and,


WHEREAS, the City Plan Commission recommended the amendment as hereinafter described for adoption of the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that:


Reclassification and rezoning of the following described real estate from the classification R-2 (multiple/<sup>family</sup> residential district) to B-2 (central business district); the description of said real estate is, to-wit:

Lots numbers 1, 2, 3, and 4, in Elisha Harkness Addition of Town Lots, situated in the City of Urbana, County of Champaign, and State of Illinois; area along the east side of South Race Street between Green Street and High Street;
