AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, OF 1950

WHEREAS, the City Plan Commission of the City of Urbana, Illinois, currently did conduct a public hearing pursuant to the required public notice, in the City Building, at the address of 400 South Vine Street, Urbana, Illinois, to consider the hereinafter described proposed amendment to the Zoning Ordinance, and,

WHEREAS, said Plan Commission at said hearing heard all persons desiring to be heard either for or against said amendment, and found that such proposed amendment was desirable for the public welfare of the City of Urbana, Illinois, and,

WHEREAS, the City Plan Commission recommended the amendment as hereinafter described for adoption of the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that:

Article VI, R-2 District - Multiple Family Residential, Section 1, Use Regulations., amended by the addition to said Section, the provision as follows:

13. Radio and television towers and stations as a Conditional Use in R-2 District (Multiple Family Residential); such Conditional Use shall be first considered in a hearing in the Plan Commission pursuant to a fifteen (15) day published notice, and then can be authorized as such Conditional Use by the Plan Commission and the City Council in respective areas.
