AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, OF 1950 6869-53

WHEREAS, the City Plan Commission of the City of Urbana, Illinois, currently did conduct a public hearing pursuant to the required public notice, in the City Building, at the address of 400 South Vine Street, Urbana, Illinois, to consider the hereinafter described proposed amendment to the Zoning Ordinance, and,

WHEREAS, said Plan Commission at said hearing heard all persons desiring to be heard either for or against said amendment, and found that such proposed amendment is desirable for the public welfare of the City of Urbana, Illinois, and that the same is not detrimental to the property owners, in the vicinity, and,

WHEREAS, the City Plan Commission recommended the amendment as hereinafter described for adoption of the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

The uses for radio and manufacture towers and stations as a Conditional Use in R-2 District, Multiple Family Residential, is declared as a use in such area; the description of said property is, to-wit:

> The East 360.00 feet of the West 390.00 feet of the South 360.00 feet of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 16, Township 19 North, Range 9 East of the Third Principal Meridian, in Champaign County, Illinois;
