

## AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the following described territory is contiguous to the City of Urbana, Illinois, a municipal corporation, and is dedicated or used for street or highway purposes under the jurisdiction of the Urbana Township Highway Department, and no part of the territory is within any other municipality;

WHEREAS, a majority of the aldermen are of the opinion that it would be for the best interests of the people of the City of Urbana, Illinois, that said territory be annexed and made a part of the City Limits of said City;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

SECTION I. That the territory described as follows, to-wit:

Lincoln Avenue extended northward between the City Limits of the City of Urbana, Illinois, a municipal corporation, and the Right-of-Way of the Interstate Highway No. I-74, in Champaign County, Illinois;

be and the same is hereby annexed to, and shall hereafter be a part of the City of Urbana, Illinois, and that the corporate limits of said Citybe and the smale shall be changed so as to include said territory within the corporate limits of said City.

SECTION II. The City Clerk of the City of Urbana, Illinois, shall record with the Recorder of Deeds of the County of Champaign, Illinois, a copy of this ordinance, together with an accurate map of the annexed territory.
