AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY TO  
THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the following described unincorporated territory is contiguous to the City of Urbana, Illinois, a municipal corporation, and is wholly surrounded by the City of Champaign, Illinois, and said City of Urbana, Illinois, and contains less than sixty (60) acres, and,

WHEREAS, a majority of the aldermen are of the opinion that it would be for the best interests of the people of the City of Urbana, Illinois, that said territory be annexed and made a part of the City Limits of said City;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:


SECTION I. That the territory described as follows, to-wit:

Said territory is located and bounded as follows: The territory is bounded on the north by said City of Champaign and by said City of Urbana, and on the east by said City of Urbana, and on the south by said City of Urbana, and on the west by said City of Champaign. Said area is in the vicinity of the intersection of Goodwin Avenue extended northward, and Bradley Avenue;


be, and the same is hereby annexed to, and shall hereafter be a part of the City of Urbana, Illinois, and that the corporate limits of said City be and the same shall be changed so as to include said territory within the corporate limits of said City.

SECTION II. The City Clerk of the City of Urbana, Illinois, shall record with the Recorder of Deeds of the county of Champaign, Illinois, a copy of this ordinance, together with an accurate map of the annexed territory.
