## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, OF 1950

WHEREAS, the City Plan Commission of the City of Urbana, Illinois, currently did conduct a public hearing pursuant to the required public notice, in the City Building, at the address of 400 South Vine Street, Urbana, Illinois, to consider the hereinafter described proposed amendment to the Zoning Ordinance, and,

WHEREAS, said Plan Commission at said hearing heard all persons desiring to be heard either for or against said amendment, and found that such proposed amendment was desirable for the public welfare of the City of Urbana, Illinois, and that the same is not detrimental to the property owners in the vicinity, and,

WHEREAS, the City Plan Commission recommended the amendment as hereinafter described for adoption of the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLENOIS, that:

Reclassification and rezoning of the following described real estate from the classification R-2, Multiple Family Residential District, to I-1, Light Industrial District; said real estate is located and bounded as follows:

The area is bounded by Orchard Street on the East, Coler Street on the West, Sassafras Alley on the South, and Clark Street and the railroad right-of-way on the North; situated in the City of Urbana, Champaign County, and State of Illinois;
