## ORDINANCE FOR MAYOR TO PROCLAIM EMERGENCY AND CURFEW IN THE EVENT OF PUBLIC EMERGENCY, NATURAL DISASTER, OR CIVIL DISORDER

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that in the event of public emergency, natural disaster, or civil disorder, the Mayor of said City is authorized to issue an enforceable proclamation for a public curfew, and to preserve peace and order by appropriate means and police actions, and otherwise, commensurate with the need as determined by the Mayor, and with advice or consultation with the Chief of Police of said City and/or the Public Safety Committee of the City Council of said City, summarily, based on consideration and conclusion by the Mayor, in the interest of public safety, conservation of peace in all parts of the City community, and for the maintenance of safety and health of the people of the municipality, and toward prevention, control, suppression and elimination of any riot, looting, or any public civil disorder, pursuant to law, and for the preservation of life, limb, and property in said municipality.
