

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY TO
THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, it appears to the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, that the herein described territory is contiguous to the City of Urbana, Illinois, and none of said territory is situated in any incorporated city or village, and, said territory is wholly bounded by the City of Urbana, Illinois, a municipality; and,

WHEREAS, said territory is located, bounded, and described as follows:

Lots #24, #26, and #27 in Lincolnwood Subdivision, situated in Champaign County, Illinois;

And, Lots #1075, #1076, #1077, and #1078 in Country Squire Estates, Second Plat, and Lots #1039, #1038, and #1037 in Country Squire Estates, First Plat; all situated in Champaign County, Illinois;

and,


WHEREAS, a majority of the aldermen are of the opinion that it would be for the best interests of the people of the City of Urbana, Illinois, that said territory be annexed to and made a part of the City of Urbana, Illinois, a municipal corporation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:


That said described territory be, and the same is hereby annexed to and shall hereafter be a part of the City of Urbana, Illinois, and that the corporate limits of said City be and the same shall be changed so as to include said territory within the corporate limits of said City.

The City Clerk of the City of Urbana, Illinois, after the passage of this ordinance of annexation, shall certify a correct copy of this ordinance, together with an accurate map, and shall file the same with the Recorder of Deeds of Champaign County, Illinois.
