

AN ORDINANCE FOR LOCATION OF FIRE HYDRANTS

WHEREAS, The Chief of the Fire Department, of the City of Urbana, Illinois, the Fire Marshall, recommends to the City Council that fire hydrants be located at the following locations, and

WHEREAS, it appears to be for the best interests of the people of the City of Urbana, Illinois, for public safety and fire protection to have such fire hydrants located, and,

WHEREAS, there is a necessity for the location of fire hydrants at the following specified locations;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that fire hydrants be located in the City of Urbana, Illinois at the following locations:

Northwest corner of Michigan Avenue and Kinch Street;
Southeast corner of Rutledge Drive and Vermont Avenue;
Northeast side of street between 1510 and 1512 Rutledge Drive;
Northeast corner of Pennsylvania Avenue and Kinch Street;

In Lincolnwood Subdivision; and

North side of Easy Street at west property line of 2002 Easy Street;
Northwest corner of Rainbow Drive and Rainbow Court;
North side at east property line of 1910 Country Squire Drive;

In Country Squire Estates Subdivision; and

Hydrant #168 on N. Webber Street at the Railroad tracks;


