ORDINANCE OF AMENDMENTS TO CITY CODE IN REGARD TO BUILDINGS EXITS AND FIRE SAFETY IN THE CITY

Whereas, for safety, certain changes are recommended in the current City Code, in regard to buildings exits requirements, and fire safety, in the City of Urbana, Illinois, a municipal corporation;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that in Chapter 8, Section 8.3 of the City Code, the words and figures: "Building Exits Code no. 101, 1963 Edition ", Be deleted. and that said Section 8.3 be amended to provide, as follows:

The National Fire Protection Association Life Safety Code No. 101, 1969 Edition, with all amendments to date, with paragraph 12 of scope and applications deleted, and substituted instead of said paragraph 12, section 1.02 (a) of the Fire Prevention Code, 1965 Edition, as recommended by the American Insurance Association, is hereby adopted as the Building Exits Code of the City and hereby made a part of this Code.

and, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that the word, Mercantile, be deleted from Section 12.5 of Chapter 12 of the City Code, and that the section 12.5 be amended to provide as follows:

All plans of new construction and/or remodeling of all business buildings and apartments buildings with three or more apartments planned must have the approval of the City Fire Inspector, on requirements, prior to the issuance of a building permit, and also particularly in regard to means of exit and other features pertaining to fire safety.
