

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY

WHEREAS, it appears to the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, that a petition was filed with the City Clerk of the City of Urbana, Illinois, on the 1st day of April A.D., 1970, requesting the annexation of the territory hereinafter described, which said petition was signed under oath by all of the owners of record of real estate and all of the electors residing in said territory, and,

WHEREAS, at least two-thirds of the aldermen are of the opinion that it would be for the best interests of the people of the City of Urbana, Illinois, that said territory be annexed to and made a part of the City Limits of said City.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS.

SECTION I. That the territory described as follows,
to-wit:


The West Half ($W\frac{1}{2}$) of the South Half ($S\frac{1}{2}$) of the North Two-Thirds ($N \frac{2}{3}$ rds) of the following property taken as a tract:

Lots 6 to 11, both inclusive, as a subdivision of the West Half ($W\frac{1}{2}$) of the Northwest Quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Nine (9); Township Nineteen North (19N), Range Nine (9) East of the Third Principal Meridian; situated in Champaign County, and the State of Illinois;


