ORDINANCE OF AMENDMENT OF AN ORDINANCE GOVERNING MINIMUM HOUSING STANDARDS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS; THAT,

AN ORDINANCE GOVERNING MINIMUM HOUSING STANDARDS, be amended, as follows: Definitions. Delete-"occupants" is any person, over three (3) years of age living or sleeping in a dwelling

unit or living unit.

Insert - "Occupants" is any person over one year of age (including owner or operator) living and sleeping in a dwelling unit or having actual possession of said dwelling or rooming unit.

Delete-Par. (a) Insert .

Natural Light in Habitable Rooms: Every habitable room shall have at least one (1) window of approved size facing directly to the outdoors or to a court. The minimum total window area, measured between stops, for every habitable room shall be ten (10) percent of the floor area of such room, except in kitchens when artificial light may be provided in accordance with the provisions of the building code. Whenever walls or other portions of a structure face a window of any room and such obstructions are located less than three (3) feet from the window and extend to a level above that of the ceiling of the room such a window shall not be deemed to face directly to the outdoors nor to a court and shall not be included as contributing to the required minimum total window area for the room.

Heating Facilities: Every dwelling and multi-family dwelling shall have heating facilities and the owner of the heating facilities shall be required to see that they are properly installed, safely maintained and in good working condition, and that they are capable of safely and adequately heating all habitable rooms, bathrooms and toilet rooms located therein, to a temperature of at least an average of seventy (70) degrees Fahrenheit with an outside temperature of ten (10) degrees below zero (0). The owner shall maintain a minimum average room temperature of seventy (70) degrees Fahrenheit in all habitable rooms including bathrooms and toilet rooms when rented, at all times on the basis of ten (10) degrees below zero (0) outside.

Occupancy of Dwelling Units Below Grade: No dwelling unit partially below grade shall be used for living purposes unless:

Floors and walls are watertight;

Total window area, total openable area and ceiling height are in accordance with this code; and

3. Required minimum window area of every habitable room is entirely above the grade of the ground adjoining such window area.
