


ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DISCHARGE OF SANITARY
AND INDUSTRIAL WASTE INTO ANY STORM SEWER
CONSTRUCTED AS A PART OF AN IMPROVEMENT OF
A PORTION OF PHILO ROAD, IN THE CITY OF
URBANA, ILLINOIS, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois, and the City of Urbana, Illinois, a municipal corporation, contemplate an improvement of Philo Road, in said City, between the intersection of Philo Road and Cottage Grove Avenue, and the southernmost city limits on Philo Road, designated as F.A.S. Route 524, State Section 200 (W,RS), City of Urbana, Champaign County, Illinois;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, a municipal corporation, for said City, that the City hereby prohibits the discharge of any sanitary or industrial waste into any storm sewer constructed as a part of said improvement of said portion of Philo Road in said City.
