

ORDINANCE NO. 7071-27

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR STREET LIGHTING IN
A PROJECT KNOWN AS N. W. LIGHTING PROJECT NO. 143-L-CS
IN THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Board of Local Improvements of the City of Urbana, Illinois, is recommending to the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, the construction of the local improvement to be known as N. W. STREET LIGHTING PROJECT NUMBER 143-L-CS in the City of Urbana, Illinois, and has presented to the City Council, this ordinance providing for the construction of said improvement, together with the revised estimate of cost of said improvement, over the signature of the Public Engineer of said City, itemized to the satisfaction of said Board and approved thereby; and,

WHEREAS, the improvement hereinafter described is a necessary local improvement which will benefit the property to be assessed in the vicinity of said improvement and will further benefit the public in the entire City of Urbana;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That N. W. STREET LIGHTING PROJECT NUMBER 143-L-CS in the City of Urbana, Illinois, consists of lighting Clark, Main, Stoughton, Romine, Matthews, Goodwin, Harvey & Gregory Streets by installing 175/250 watt Mercury Vapor fixtures in an area bounded by University, Springfield, Lincoln and Romine Streets, and 400 watt Mercury Vapor fixtures on Springfield Avenue between Lincoln and Burrell Streets, together with necessary electrical cable, control accessories and other material necessary for completion. All work and construction hereinabove provided for shall be done in conformity with the plans and specifications prepared by Clark, Dietz and Associates, and on file with the City Engineer, and made a part of this ordinance by reference.

SECTION 2. That the location and construction of said improvement shall in all respects conform to the detailed plans, plats, maps, profiles, revised estimates and specifications hereto attached, and that all materials and appliances used in the construction of said improvement shall be in the

size, shape, style, dimensions, proportions and quality provided in the attached drawings, specifications and revised estimate, and the said improvement shall be installed at the places and in the manner as provided in said drawings and specifications.

SECTION 3. The attached plans, plats, profiles, maps, specifications and revised estimate providing for the manner of construction of said improvement are expressly made a part of this ordinance by reference as fully and completely as if the same had been incorporated herein in full, and shall in all respects govern and control the construction and location of said improvement and the materials entering into the same, and in the interpretation of said plans, plats, profiles and specifications, the decisions of the Board of Local Improvements with reference thereto shall be final and binding.

SECTION 4. The construction of said improvement, including all work and materials therefor, as provided in this ordinance, is hereby declared to be a necessary local improvement, and shall be constructed at the place hereinbefore mentioned, and the whole cost thereof including the costs and expenses of levying the collection of special assessments shall be paid by a special assessment on all the property specially benefited by the construction of said improvement to the extent of the special benefits thereon and by a general tax on all the property in the City of Urbana, Illinois, for the public benefits, to the extent of the public benefits thereon.

SECTION 5. The Council finds that said Board of Local Improvements is legally constituted as provided by Statute, and that the revised estimate of the cost of said improvement over the signature of the Public Engineer, submitted with the recommendations of said Board of Local Improvements and approved by the same, is hereby adopted and approved by the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, and the copy thereof hereto attached, being the estimate of cost as adopted at the public hearing on said improvement and as revised subsequently by the City Engineer of said City, as allowable and authorized, is hereby made a part of this ordinance by reference as aforesaid.

SECTION 6. That the aggregate amount herein ordered to be assessed against the property and also the assessment against each lot, block, tract and parcel of land therein assessed, shall be divided into ten installments in the manner provided by the Statute in such cases made and provided, and each of said installments shall bear interest at the rate of six per cent per annum according to law.

SECTION 7. That for the purpose of anticipating the collection of the aforesaid second and succeeding installments, provided for in this ordinance, the City of Urbana, Illinois, shall issue bonds to be issued in the sum of One Hundred Dollars each, or some multiple thereof, and shall be issued in accordance with and shall in all respects conform to the provisions of said Local Improvement Act.

SECTION 8. The Corporation Counsel of the City of Urbana, Illinois, is hereby directed to file a petition in the name of the City of Urbana, Illinois, in the Circuit Court of Champaign County, Illinois, praying that steps be taken to levy a special assessment for said improvement in accordance with the provisions of this ordinance and the laws of the State of Illinois.


SECTION 9. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
