BE IT ORDAINED BY THE URBANA CITY COUNCIL THAT:

No person shall wilfully fail or refuse to comply with any lawful order of direction of a Police Officer if such person knows that the person giving the order or direction is a Police Officer and the order or direction is an authorized act within the official capacity of the Police Officer giving such order or direction. Upon conviction of violating this Ordinance, a person shall be fined in accordance with Section 1.6 of the City Code.

Former section 20.14 of the City Code of Urbana is hereby repealed upon the foregoing Section becoming effective.
