

ORDINANCE NO. 7071-31

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 7071-26  
AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF PUBLIC AND PRIVATE  
SEWERS AND DRAINS, PRIVATE SEWAGE DISPOSAL, THE  
INSTALLATION AND CONNECTION OF BUILDING SEWERS, AND  
DISCHARGE OF WATERS AND WASTES INTO THE PUBLIC SEWER  
SYSTEMS: AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF:  
IN THE CITY OF URBANA, COUNTY OF CHAMPAIGN, STATE OF ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 7071-26 was adopted by the City Council of the City of Urbana on July 6, 1970, and approved by the Mayor on the same day, and

WHEREAS, the said Ordinance, as adopted, contains a technical error which should be corrected,

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, STATE OF ILLINOIS, as follows:

1. That the first paragraph of Section 27.12 - Use Of The Public Sewers, be amended to read as follows:

No person shall discharge or cause to be discharged any stormwater, surface water, groundwater, roof runoff, sub-surface drainage, uncontaminated cooling water, or unpolluted industrial process waters to any sanitary sewer. Water from footing tiles may not be discharged to a sanitary sewer through a sump pump, or by any other means. Footing tiles shall be discharged to a storm sewer when one is available.

This Amendatory Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of publication thereof.
