

AN ORDINANCE CODE REGULATING THE
SALE AT RETAIL OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS
WITHIN THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
URBANA, ILLINOIS, THAT:

Section 16.8 (Number of Licenses) of An Ordinance Code Regulating
The Sale At Retail Of Alcoholic Liquors Within The City Of Urbana, Illinois, shall be
amended and is hereby amended to read as follows:

Not more than one Class A or AA license shall be issued in
any one year for each 2,500 population of the city. Not
more than one Class AAA license shall be issued in any one
year for each 5,000 population of the city. Not more than
one Class B license shall be issued for each 5,000 population
of the city. Not more than one Class C license shall be
issued for each 5,000 population of the city. The population
of the city for such purposes shall be determined by the latest
motor fuel tax census or by the federal census, whichever is
later.
