

ORDINANCE NO 7071-55

AN ORDINANCE CODE REGULATING THE
SALE AT RETAIL OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS
WITHIN THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, THAT:

1. All of the present Ordinance Sections 16.14 and all sub-sections thereunder are hereby repealed.

2. In place of Section 16.14 shall be the following:

SECTION 16.14 Hours

(a) Except as prohibited elsewhere in this Ordinance, or by law, alcoholic liquor may be sold or offered for sale at any time, except as follows:

Monday through Saturday - between the hours of 1 A.M. and 6 A.M.
Sunday - between the hours of 1 A.M. and 12 Noon.

At any time when January 1 shall fall on a day other than Sunday, alcoholic liquor may be sold or offered for sale at any time, except between the hours of 2 A.M. through 6 A.M. When January 1 shall fall on a Sunday, alcoholic liquor may be sold or offered for sale at any time, except between the hours of 2 A.M. until 12 Noon.


All times referred to herein shall be local time.

(b) The premises of each license where liquor is sold or offered for sale must be vacated within 1 hour after the closing hour as required in (a) above, except for the owner or manager and custodial personnel.

(c) Each licensee shall post in at least two (2) prominent places in the licensed premises, the hours of closing and the hour by which the premises must be vacated by all unauthorized persons.

3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the adoption and approval by the Mayor and upon its due publication.
