

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN
TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF URBANA

WHEREAS a Petition signed by a majority of the owners of record of the land in the following described territory, and also signed by a majority of the electors residing in the territory described hereinafter was filed in the Circuit Court of Champaign County on September 18, 1970, and

WHEREAS, it was later determined that a portion of the territory described in the Petition was a part of the Edge-Scott Fire Protection District and the requisite statutory notice had not been given to the said District and, therefore, the prior action of the City Council on December 1, 1970, purporting to annex the said territory was involved, and

WHEREAS, the prior Order of the Court was vacated and due and proper notice was then given to the Edge-Scott Fire Protection District, and

WHEREAS Notice by publication was made on the 13th day of December, 1970, that the Petition for Annexation would be heard by the Court on December 18, 1970, and said Hearing was continued until January 12, 1971, and

WHEREAS, on January 12th, 1971, the Court duly found that as to some of the territory described in the Petition, it was true and valid in all respects, and directed that the Corporate authority of the City of Urbana consider the question of annexation for final action,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS,

1. That the following described territory, to-wit:

Lots 2, 3, 33, 39, 68, 70, 97, 98, 99, 100, 104, 105, 130 through 136 inclusive and Florida Avenue from the East line of Lot 136 through the intersection with Lincolnwood Drive, Lincolnwood Drive from Florida to the North line of Lot 130, Michigan Avenue from the East line of Lot 39 through the intersection with Kinch Drive, Kinch Drive from the intersection with Michigan to the South line of Lot 39, Kinch Drive in front of Lot 68, Kinch Drive from the North line of Lot 70 through the intersection with Vermont, and Vermont from the intersection with Kinch to the West line of Lot 70 all in Weller's Lincolnwood, a subdivision in Champaign County, Illinois,

be and the same is hereby annexed to and shall be hereafter a part of the City of Urbana, Illinois, and the Corporate limits of the said City be and the same shall be changed to include said territory within the Corporate limits of the City of Urbana.

2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on the expir-


ation of 30 days from the date of its passage unless a referendum thereon shall be subsequently ordered by said City Council or unless a Petition for such referendum shall be filed with the City Clerk of said City. In case of such a referendum, this Ordinance shall be of full force and effect if a majority of the electors voting upon the question favor the annexation of said territory to the City of Urbana. If a majority of the electors voting upon the question vote against such annexation, then this Ordinance shall become null and void.



BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS,

1. That the following described territory, to-wit:

Lots 2, 3, 33, 39, 68, 70, 97, 98, 99, 100, 104, 105, 130 through 136 inclusive and Florida Avenue from the East line of Lot 136 through the intersection with Lincolnwood Drive, Lincolnwood Drive from Florida to the North line of Lot 130, Michigan Avenue from the East line of Lot 39 through the intersection with Kinch Drive, Kinch Drive from the intersection with Michigan to the South line of Lot 39, Kinch Drive in front of Lot 68, Kinch Drive from the North line of Lot 70 through the intersection with Vermont, and Vermont from the intersection with Kinch to the West line of Lot 70 all in Weller's Lincolnwood, a subdivision in Champaign County, Illinois,

be and the same is hereby annexed to and shall be hereafter a part of the City of Urbana, Illinois, and the Corporate limits of the said City be and the same shall be changed to include said territory within the Corporate limits of the City of Urbana.

2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on the expir-

ation of 30 days from the date of its passage unless a referendum thereon shall be subsequently ordered by said City Council or unless a Petition for such referendum shall be filed with the City Clerk of said City. In case of such a referendum, this Ordinance shall be of full force and effect if a majority of the electors voting upon the question favor the annexation of said territory to the City of Urbana. If a majority of the electors voting upon the question vote against such annexation, then this Ordinance shall become null and void.



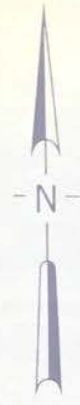
