
Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from after its passage and recording as provided by law.

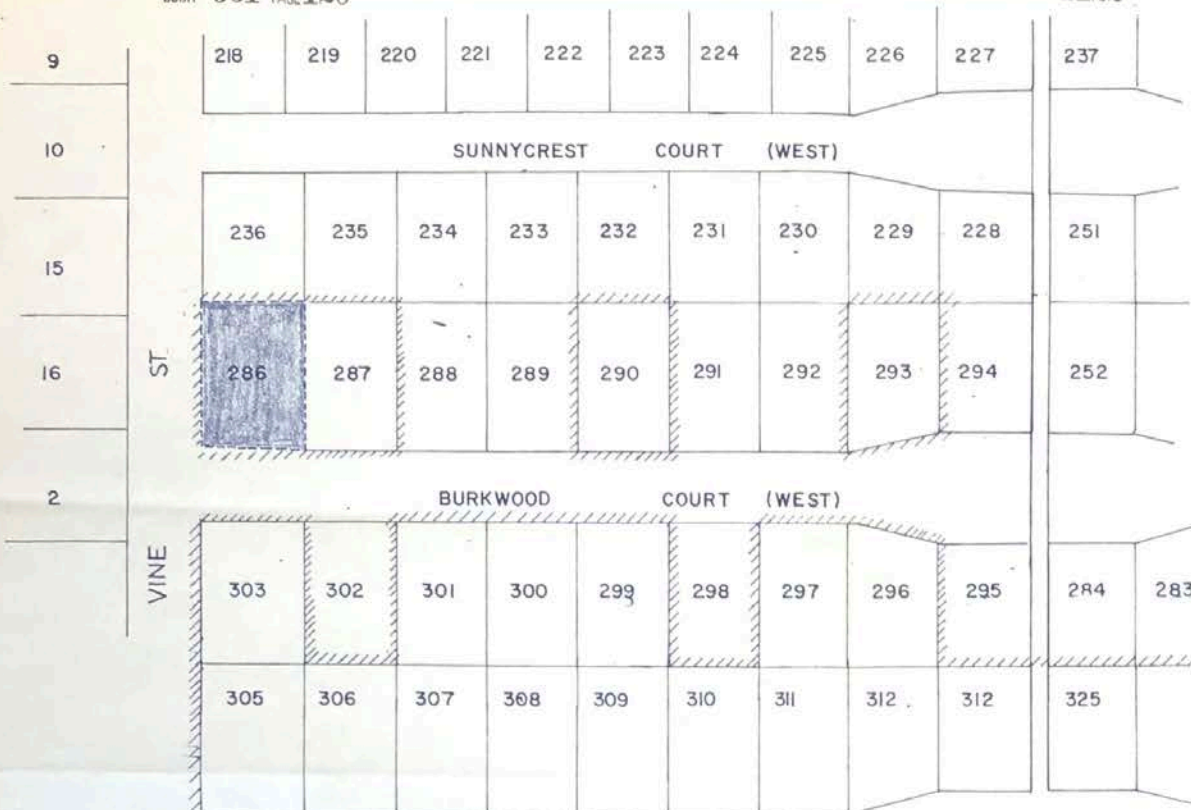
