

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT AND INSTALLATION  
OF FOUR-WAY STOP SIGNS AT THE INTERSECTIONS  
OF PHILO ROAD (STATE ROUTE #130) AND WASHINGTON  
STREET: AND ALSO THE INTERSECTION OF PHILO ROAD  
(STATE ROUTE #130) AND FLORIDA AVENUE

WHEREAS, the CITY OF URBANA, in the interest of public safety,  
has requested the Illinois Division of Highways, District 5, Paris Office, Traffic Engineering  
Department to undertake a traffic investigation of the intersections of Philo Road (State Route  
#130) and Washington; and also Philo Road (State Route #130) and Florida, and

WHEREAS, the results of these engineering and traffic investigations  
have indicated that the establishment of four-way stop signs at these locations were warranted,  
and


WHEREAS, the above Illinois Highway Division has agreed to erect  
these said signs upon the passage of an Ordinance directing the establishment thereof,

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE URBANA CITY COUNCIL that:


Section 1. There shall be a four-way stop at the intersection of Philo  
Road (State Route #130) and Washington Street, and the intersection of Philo Road (State  
Route #130) and Florida Avenue, and the appropriate signs are hereby and herewith authorized  
to be erected designating such.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its  
passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1 - 2 - 4 of the Illinois  
Municipal Code.
