

AN ORDINANCE FOR LOCATION OF FIRE HYDRANTS

WHEREAS, the Chief of the Fire Department of the City of Urbana, Illinois, the Fire Marshall, recommends to the City Council that fire hydrants be located at the following locations, and

WHEREAS, it appears to be for the best interests of the People Of The City of Urbana, Illinois, for public safety and fire protection to have such fire hydrants located, and


WHEREAS, there is a necessity for the location of fire hydrants of the following specified locations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that fire hydrants be located in the City of Urbana, Illinois, at the following locations:

1. North Maple Street approximately 15 feet north of the Penn-Central RR tracks, East side of the street.
2. Northwest corner of Oakland and Geraldine.
3. Northeast corner Easy and Kinch Streets.


