

ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY
TO THE CITY OF URBANA

WHEREAS, the hereinafter described territory is situated in unincorporated territory adjacent to and contiguous to the City of Urbana, Illinois, and is a part of the Eastern Prairie Fire Protection District, and Notice was given to the Trustees of the said Fire Protection District, said Notice being mailed on September 16, 1971, that this Ordinance would be voted upon at the regular meeting of the Urbana City Council at 7:30 P.M. Monday, October 4, 1971, and the Affidavit of Mailing such Notices was duly recorded with the Recorder of Deeds of Champaign County, Illinois, and

WHEREAS, there are no electors residing on the said territory, and

WHEREAS, the territory is owned by the City of Urbana, and

WHEREAS, a majority of the Aldermen are of the opinion that it would be for the best interests of the People of the City of Urbana, Illinois, that the said territory be annexed to the City of Urbana,

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS,

Section 1. That the following described real estate, viz:

The South 135 feet of the West 150 feet of the East 183 feet of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 7, Township 19 North, Range 9 East of the Third Principal Meridian, Champaign County, Illinois, said tract containing 0.46 acres more or less, all situated in Champaign County, Illinois,

commonly known as 1405 - 1407 North Lincoln Avenue, Urbana, Illinois,

be and the same is hereby annexed to the City of Urbana, Illinois.



Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from after its passage and recording as provided by law.


This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana,
